

WHEREAS Chutka Madhya Pradesh Atomic Power Project (CMPAPP), NUCLEAR POWER CORPORATION OF INDIA LIMITED, CHUTKA MADHYA PRADESH" CMPAPP is wholly owned by the Government of India and is responsible for the generation of electricity from nuclear power. NPCIL is administered by the Department of Atomic Energy.

1. Background

An MoU has been signed between NPCIL, HO at Mumbai and EdCIL (India) Limited on 07th June 2023 for 5 nos. units of NPCIL for 3 years, where in it has been agreed that EdCIL shall act as Turnkey service provider to undertake end-to-end CSR activities execution through Project Management Consultancy (PMC) with the following scope of work:

- i) To assist in planning CSR activities in accordance to the DPE guidelines and theme thereof for a particular year.
- ii) To prepare a Need Assessment report for the educational and other social service sectors for the consideration of CSR Board/Committee of NPCIL for finalization of areas and activities with estimated amount against each head/sector.
- iii) To implement the approved CSR activities through transparent procurement process by undertaking preparation of Estimate, Tendering and Selection of agency through empanelment / tendering with due diligence.
- iv) To monitor procurement process, services, commissioning, handing over and handholding for a period of 3 years against each year CSR projects and may be extended further as per mutual agreement.
- v) To manage events / social media / print media / awareness and visibility of CSR activities of NPCIL.
- vi) To organize reports/ analytics/ Impact Assessment/ improvements etc. on NPCIL's CSR activities executed by EdCIL and ongoing CSR projects.

NPCIL Board Level CSR Committee approved engaging EdCIL in **CSR activities** at following green/brown field sites:

- (i) Jaitapur Nuclear Power Project, Ratnagiri, Maharashtra,
- (ii) Gorakhpur Haryana Anu Vidyut Pariyojana (GHAVP), and
- (iii) Nuclear Power Project, Kovvada, Andhra Pradesh.
- (iv) Mahi Banswada, Rajasthan Atomic Power Project (MBRAPP),
- (v) Chutka Madhya Pradesh Atomic Power Project (CMPAPP)**

Subsequently, it was also agreed that a separate MoU will be signed between EdCIL and each of the individual sites of NPCIL (05 nos. as given above). The said MoU shall be project based MOU with CMPAPP site and consist the Scope of work and other terms and conditions. The finalization of the projects for each of the individual site, shall be done by EdCIL based on the Need Assessment survey of the schools, in consultation with the local administration, with in the catchment area of the particular site of NPCIL.

2. Need Assessment Survey of Govt. Schools in & around CMPAPP, NPCIL site

EdCIL has conducted a Need Assessment Survey of Govt. schools in District Mandla, Madhya Pradesh. The purpose of the Need Assessment was to identify the preliminary requirements to enable the Govt. schools with 'basic infrastructure' and 'facilities' viz. latest tech-based labs to facilitate the students to easily understand the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics) etc. subjects. And as an outcome of the Need Assessment survey, it is recommended to implement the various interventions in all the Govt. schools in phase-wise manner with in a time span of three years.

After Scrutinizing need assessment report of EdCIL, District Administration has agreed to Execute the following projects:

But in such schools where 1000 sqft area will not be available, reduced no. of interventions will be provided. The rates of individual interventions shall be applicable in that case,

(ii) EdCIL shall execute the above projects on Turnkey basis Including Teacher's training, baseline & endline survey etc.

(iii) To organize reports/ analytics/ Impact Assessment/ improvements etc. on NPCIL's CSR activities executed by EdCIL for This CSR project.

5. **Stages of Payment:** Refer MoU (between NPCIL, Mumbai and EdCIL) Clause no. 1. The payment terms and stages shall be regulated as follows:

Note:

- i) The payment of consultancy fees over and above the actual cost of construction/procurement arrived after tendering from CSR fund will be 5% of the project cost as indicated clause #4. The consultancy fee@5% will be disbursed against each milestone as indicated in preceding table.
- ii) For stage 01, the payment shall be calculated on the basis of estimated cost.
- iii) Total cost means the cost arrived after tender process by EdCIL for selection of supplier

- iv) The payment as per stages indicated above will be released to EdCIL after submission of EdCIL's Invoice/ Demand Letter in order to complete the project on time.
- v) EdCIL shall comply all GST and other tax norms as per the stipulation of government guidelines.

6. EdCIL's Markup:

EdCIL charge its consultancy fee on the basis of Volume of Work/scope of work. For above said scope of work consultancy fee shall be @5% as indicated in clause#4 on the total final cost arrived on actual execution of CSR activities including of all manpower, printing, social media, tender/empanelment, transportation etc..

8. OBLIGATIONS OF CMPAPP, Madhya Pradesh

Following obligations of CMPAPP are felt necessary for successful execution of the project:

- i) CMPAPP will appoint a Nodal person for co-ordination with EdCIL for smooth execution of project.
- ii) Whenever required CMPAPP will approve the deliverables for proceeding for next stage.
- iii) Beneficiary schools to provide suitable sites (physical space) for storage of equipment / items at the time of execution.
- iv) Beneficiary schools/CMPAPP to issue necessary certificate / forms required for delivery & installation of equipment / items.

9. GENERAL

6.1 Termination and Breach of Agreement

In the event of any adverse occurrence or situation which may render carrying out the obligations under this Agreement unworkable beyond the reasonable controls, the party affected to this Agreement thereby, shall notify the other, in writing within 15 days about such occurrence / situation. Upon the receipt of such notice, the affected party shall be relieved from its liability subject to bearing of the cost incurred earlier to such occurrence / situation and related thereto by invoking this clause at the time of termination.

In case of breach of agreement by either of parties, the other party sustaining thereby loss, will have claim for reasonable and all consequential damages including cost of future litigation and third party liabilities to whom any work is assigned by either of the party of this contract for any goods or services, from its counterpart.

6.2 Amendment to the Agreement

The obligations of NPCIL and EdCIL have been provided here in-before. However, during the period of the Agreement, circumstances may arise which call for alteration or modification of this Agreement. These modifications/ alterations will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing.

6.3 Settlement of Disputes/Arbitration

6.3.1 In the event of any question, dispute and/or difference whatsoever arises or will arise under this Agreement or in connection therewith including any questions as to existence, meaning and interpretation of any Clause of this Agreement or any alleged breach thereof, the same shall be settled as far as possible by mutual discussions and consultations between the parties to this Agreement.

6.3.2 In the event of dispute and/or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of this MOU, such dispute or difference shall be taken up by either party for resolution through AMRCD as mentioned in DPE OM No. 4(1)/2013-DPE(GM)/FTS-1835 dated 22-05-2018.

6.4 Applicability of Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the Law of India.

6.5 Language

The ruling language according to which the Agreement is to be construed and interpreted shall be the English Language.

6.6 FORCE MAJEURE

For the purpose of this contract "Force Majeure" means an event which is beyond the reasonable control of a party and which makes a party's performance of its obligations hereunder impossible or so impractical as reasonably to be considered impossible in the circumstances and includes but not limited to war, riots, civil disorder, earthquake, fire explosion, storm, flood or other adverse weather conditions, strikes, lockouts or other industrial action (except where such strikes, lockouts or other industrial actions are within



the power of the party invoking Force Majeure to prevent), confiscation or any other action by government agencies.

Force Majeure shall not include (i) any event which is caused by the negligence or intentional action of a Party or such Party's sub- consultants or agents or employees nor (ii) any event which a diligent Party could reasonably have expected to both (A) take into account at time of conclusion of this contract and (B) avoid or overcome in the carrying out of its obligations hereunder.

6.7 JURISDICTION

All matters under this Agreement and in connection with this Agreement shall be subject to jurisdiction of Mandla/Jabalpur courts.

6.8 PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

To safeguard the warranty period obligation a performance bank guarantee shall be obtained by EdCIL from each vendors deployed on CSR projects up to the period of completion of warranty.

10. EFFECTIVENESS AND DURATION OF AGREEMENT

7.1 This Agreement shall be deemed to have come into force on the date of signing of the Agreement.
